2019 Horse Schedule - Horse Rules & Regulations

1. **Please see QCAS rules for full list of rules for QCAS affiliated events.**
2. Judges – NO competitor can approach the judge at anytime. All requests must be made through the steward or committee member.
3. NO HELMET - NO RIDE. Helmets must be worn at all times whilst on ANY HORSE WHILST on the grounds during the show from Friday, Saturday and Sunday INCLUDING in warm up, marshalling and during all classes.
4. **Disputes and protests – If you have a dispute or protest regarding judges, stewards, competitors or general public please go through the correct channels to rectify the dispute. All disputes must be in writing and submitted to the secretary office with a non-refundable deposit of \$200.00 within 60 minutes of completion of event in question. Committee decision will be final.**
5. Measuring can be arranged Friday and Saturday mornings prior to show commencement if requested ONLY. Please contact show if you require horse measured. This will not be an official measurement but will be suitable for competition at the Wallumbilla show. Horses that are EFA registered or have a Show horse council current height certificate do not have to be measured, but will require to produce horse and papers for checking at measuring. If a horse is found to be competing in an incorrect height class this horse will be disqualified from competing for the duration of the show and all prize money, ribbons and points received during the show will be forfeited back to the Wallumbilla A & P Association.
6. **CRUELTY TO HORSES** -. No Exhibitor shall engage or be knowingly involved in cruelty to a horse. The WA&P ass shall be the sole Judge of what constitutes cruelty, but it may include:
 - a. to whip or beat a horse excessively,
 - b. to subject a horse to any kind of electric shock,
 - c. to use spurs, or to jab the horse in the mouth with the bit, excessively or persistently,
 - d. to remount, or attempt to remount, an exhausted, lame or injured horse,
 - e. to rap a horse,
 - f. to hypersensitise any part of a horse,
 - g. to leave a horse without adequate food, drink or exercise,
 - h. excessive exercise, (no horse can be lunged for longer period than 45min without having a 30min break between work)Any case of cruelty must be reported immediately to the Chairman of the Ring Committee, accompanied by documentary evidence in support. Reports more than 14 days after the occurrence will not be considered.
7. The committee reserves the rights to cancel any event or alter the conditions of entry to any event due to insufficient nomination.
8. **PONIES** Either an adult or child can lead all led ponies, unless otherwise stated. An adult must lead pony stallions. Open Show Pony hacks and show hunters 12.2 hands and under must be ridden by child under 17 years. Adults are permitted to ride all ponies over 12.2hands.
9. **LOCAL** events defined to be any person who receives their mail through a Post Office in the Maranoa Regional Council Shire or reside within the Maranoa Regional Council Shire Boundary. All persons and their mounts must reside for at least three calendar months prior to commencement or the show within the shire to be eligible to compete in local events.
10. **NEWCOMER** events are open to all horses that have not competed under saddle in any event except racing prior to 1st July 2017.
11. **NOVICE** horse having won any Open hack or hunter Championship at an ag show or a first in an open hack class at a royal show (Hunter or Hack) must then progress to Open classes. If your horse has won an Open Hack Championship it can't compete in Novice Hunter Classes and vice versa. If an Open horse is found to be competing in a novice class this horse will be disqualified from competing for the duration of the show and all prize money, ribbons and points received during the show will be forfeited back to the Wallumbilla A & P Association.
12. **NOVICE, OPEN AND LOCAL HACKS & HUNTERS EXCEEDING 15 HANDS** - must be ridden by person 12 years and over.
13. Stallions are eligible to compete only in events specified to be open to them. Any Colt or Stallion two years or over must be led with a bit or chain and bar and have an adequately strong head stall. Chief Stewards have the right to remove any stallion they consider unsafe.
14. Age of all horses to be as from 1st August, Every horse foaled before 1st August in any years shall be deemed to be one year old at that date.
15. **Nominations will be a ticket system.** Tickets will be available for purchase from horse ring office, name of competitor and horse must be written on ticket prior to entering ring. Method of tickets will be as you enter the ring, a steward of each ring will collect tickets before each event. Please have all tickets completed with your name, horse's name and the number of event you are competing in. **Unused or written on tickets will NOT be refunded so please choose events carefully.** Ring prize money will be paid at the horse ring office on the completion of each event. All prize money unclaimed by Saturday after completion of events will revert back to the Society. Show jump prize money to be collected from main secretary office. First prize money will be awarded except where trophies are given. In which case only the trophy will be awarded. In the event of a tie in an event, ribbons will be given to each competitor, but prize money will be divided in half.
16. No child 17 years & under is eligible to ride in a lady's or gent's show Hack or Galloway or hunter classes.
17. All competitors must assemble in the defined marshalling area before an event. Marshalling means 3 calls for any event then an entrance call. After this, the gate will be shut. PLEASE do not wait in laneways for safety reasons
18. Should competitors wish to compete in more than one event that overlap, they must choose which event to forfeit as no event will be held waiting for a competitor in another event.
19. The horse events are operated under the rules of the Q.C.A.S and A.H.H.A.

20. Ruling for Horse Doping

A. If a positive swab is recorded for a banned substance the cost of the swabbing of \$700.00 and a fine of \$1500.00 will be due and payable to the Wallumbilla A & P Association, with other penalties incurred at the discretion of the Equestrian Federation of Australia and Q.C.A.S. All prize money, trophies, ribbons and points received during the show will be forfeited back to the W.A & P Ass.

B. The Competitor with a positive test result and any horse owned by competitor will also be banned from competing at the Wallumbilla A & P Show for a period of 3 years.

C. A list of banned substance is available for your information online on the Equestrian Queensland web site.

21. **Bullying**- Every official, competitor and helper has the right to be treated with dignity and respect prior, during and after completion of the show. The WA&PA Ring Committee have a responsibility to ensure this occurs at our events. The WA&PA Ring Committee can only discipline the appropriate persons if intimidation is reported. We encourage any person who feels they have been bullied to report it in writing to the WA&PA Ring Committee:

A. Reports will be handled promptly and confidentially

B. Disciplinary action will be taken against those who have bullied others at events run under the auspices of the WA&PC Ring Committee

C. This also includes bullying on social media either by personal messages or public posts. Cyber Bullying will not be tolerated and disciplinary action will be taken.

22. Horse registrations and society memberships - Current Membership tickets where applicable and Registration Papers must be presented on request for breed or society classes. All horses competing in the registered breed society classes must be registered and proof of registration will be requested. If horse or competitor is found competing in a class they are not allowed to be in they will be asked to remove themselves from the class. ALL RESULTS WILL BE FORWARDED ONTO THEIR RESPECTIVE SOCIETIES FOR CHECKING OF CURRENT MEMBERSHIPS.

23. In the event of a class having a large number of entries - The judge has the right to divide the class into two groups as he/she sees fit. The three highest placing's will be selected from each group. The group will then come together and compete for the overall winners of the class.

24. This Society provides First Aid Assistance on the grounds during the show but the responsibility of AMBULANCE TRANSPORT remains with the patient whatever their involvement in the show.

25. RESTRICTED AREA - In the efforts of safety, all horses will be restricted to their gazetted area. Horses will be permitted to exercise near the cricket ground with access via the southern side of the arena. Any horse and rider found west of the bar, toilet block will suffer immediate disqualification from their events. HORSES are definitely NOT ALLOWED anywhere near the PAVILION, CANTEEN OR BAR areas.

26. **RING 4 Saturday** — Events are for **Beginner/Novice** Horses and Riders only, under 12 years of age. If a Rider/horse combination has won a blue ribbon in an open class at a royal show or a champion hack/hunter ribbon at an agricultural show they are no longer deemed a beginner rider/horse combination. If you wish to compete in events in Ring 4 you must stay competing in this ring for the duration of the day. You can still compete in your horses registered **led** breed classes or local hack classes on Friday and Saturday. Please note – this ring is for **beginner** riders only that are either led or at the walk and trot stage of riding. (ie if your child can ride unattended at the canter they are no longer eligible for beginner ring)

27. Judging Rules for ANSA horses

Preference for ANSA Attire including ANSA Saddlecloth but not compulsory · confirmation first and foremost · good calm temperament and goes forward and light in hand with a straight gait · an ANSA horse must be a comfortable riding horse · must be ridden in a snaffle bit only · no artificial aids · a workout - the workout is to be in both directions at all paces.

a. **Show & Hunter Classes** Horses must either compete in the Novice Show Hunter Classes and working hunter horse classes or in the Novice and Open hack Classes they may not compete in both on Friday or Saturday. Once you have competed as a hunter or hack in either led or ridden you **CANNOT** change classes.

Show Hunter classes include Show Hunter Gala, ring 1 classes 13-16 and 25-43. Ring 2 classes 71-80.

Ring 3 classes 213-229.

b. Classes will be judged as per the guidelines as set out by the Aust Hunter Horse Assoc. Refer to Rules & Regulations as set out on their website: - www.hunterhorses.com.au before entering this ring. Classes 217, 222 & 227 are AHHA points qualifying classes.

c. Hunter Ponies may be ridden by an adult in classes specified

28. **HORSE HOUSING** – stable map and details are available on Nominate, please book and pay via the web site. Sawdust will be available in all stables. Once stables are full we will erect portable yards so every competitor will be catered for.

Any horses found to be competing in an incorrect class at this show will be disqualified from competing for the duration of the show and all prize money, ribbons and points received during the show will be forfeited back to the Wallumbilla A & P Association. Depending on committee decision the horse and or rider may face bans between 1 and 5 years from competing at this show and all information will be forwarded to qcas for further disciplinary action. All horses must have a horse health declaration, waiver & swabbing form completed
