ENTRIES CLOSE MIDDAY FRIDAY 30th April

All entries must be submitted to Wallumbilla Show Pavilion, or to the Photography Steward. Late entries will be accepted on morning of Show but committee would appreciate if entries were forwarded by the due date, to make it easier to hang photos.

RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Entries must have been photographed by the entrant.
2. All entries must have been taken in the last 3 years, from 2018 onwards.
3. **Any** person may enter the Open section.
4. The Steward or Judge may re-categorize an entry if it is necessary.
5. A maximum of **SIX** entries per exhibitor in each class.
6. All entries are to be clearly marked with name, address, phone number and category on the back of each entry.
7. All entries must be securely mounted on A5 piece of white paper (A5 is half of an A4 piece of paper). Photos **cannot** be any bigger than 5'x7' (13cm x 18cm)
8. All Photos must be printed on Photo paper, **not** plain paper.
9. Instructions for return, plus postage if needed, must be included with entries.
10. Entries from previous Wallumbilla Show Photography competitions are excluded.
11. If the judge decides that none of the entries are worthy then no prize will be awarded.
12. All entries are to be collected from the pavilion at the conclusion of the show on Saturday **after** 6pm. If entries are not collected within the designated period, they will be disposed of – unless prior arrangements have been made.
13. **Junior Section** – Juniors may only enter their age category to which they fall in at time of the show ie: if they are 8 before 1st May 2021 they must go in the 8 years and under section.
14. The same image cannot be entered in more than one class.
15. **People's Choice vote** – Voting opens from 9am Saturday and closes 3pm Saturday of the show, votes will be counted and the winner awarded a prize.
16. **Stewards and Judges only will be permitted in the Pavilion during Judging**
17. No second prize money will be awarded if there are less than three entries in any one class.
