All entries must be presented to the pavilion along with nomination forms **before 12 midday**

on Friday 5th May 2023 no late entries accepted.

All entries are to be new, the work of the competitor and not previously entered in the Wallumbilla Show. Synthetic yarns are acceptable but if entries are judged equal in quality, then pure wool or wool blend has preference. Stewards have the right to enter an item into a different category if deemed necessary.

Definitions:

Garment is only one item

For example in knitting and crocheting

– a jumper, beanie, scarf are garments.

A layette is not as it has more than

one piece – could use the jacket as a garment.

For example is sewing – a blouse,

skirt, dress, pants are a garment but a skirt and top

together is an outfit and could be entered as two

separate entries

KNITTING AND CROCHET

Class

- 8001. Childs/Adults knitted garment
- 8002. Article in fine crochet – number 40 or over
- 8003. Article in course crochet
- 8004. Article or garment – crochet using no more than 100 grams of wool
- 8005. Article or garment – knitted using no more than 100 grams of wool
- 8006. Knitted or crocheted toy
- 8007. Knitted or crocheted rug
- 8008. Any article knitted not previously listed
- 8009. Any article crocheted not previously listed



EMBROIDERY AND NEEDLE WORK

Class

- 8010. Article or garment in cross stitch
- 8011. Cross stitch framed
- 8012. Article or garment in embroidery

- 8013. Embroidered picture – framed
- 8014. Article using Sashiko Panels

MACHINE WORK

Class

- 8015. Machine sewn garment
- 8016. Machine sewn novelty article

PATCHWORK

Class

- 8017. Article in patchwork – machine quilted by entrant
- 8018. Article in patchwork – hand quilted by entrant
- 8019. Article in patchwork – commercially quilted
- 8020. Article of patchwork – not quilted
- 8021. Quilt in Appliqué
- 8022. Article in Applique
- 8023. Patchwork article using ‘Paper Piecing’
- 8024. Article in patchwork using three techniques (eg: applique, embroidery, patchwork piecing)

MISCELLANEOUS

Class

- 8025. Toy – hand or machine sewn
- 8026. Novelty article (such as pot holder, coat hanger, cushion etc.)
- 8027. Something new from something old (state origin)
- 8028. Bag – any medium
- 8029. Wall Hanging any medium
- 8030. Any Tatted article or lace making

- 8032. 1 greeting card – any medium
